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### *What do they need?*

- **Developmentally**

They are asking: Do I have friends? They are motivated by fun.  
Respond by: Engaging their interests

- **Spiritually**

Provoke discovery so they will trust God's character and experience God's family.

**Basic Truths to teach and reinforce:**

- I should treat others the way I want to be treated.
  - I can trust God no matter what.
  - I need to make the wise choice.
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### *How to lead at home*

- **Provide opportunities to serve family and friends.**

(e.g. delivering a meal, helping someone move).

- **Ask how you can pray for them and with them.**

- **Memorize scripture together and ask what they are learning.**
